

United Council of Corvette Clubs Educational Scholarship Fund



The United Council of Corvette Clubs (UCCC) Educational Scholarship Fund was established in 2015 under President, Larry Tunstall and members of the Executive Board. The purpose of this scholarship is to help nurture, promote and develop our youth and young adults into becoming viable citizens and community servants. The UCCC scholarship provides financial assistance to students who are in pursuit of achieving a higher education via intellect or technical skills that will advance and enhance their career objectives. The fund is available to dependent son(s), daughter(s) and legally adopted children and grandchildren of members in good standing of the UCCC, including Members at Large. The scholarship is a one-time opportunity for students demonstrating educational excellence and community involvement. Students must be enrolled in a two-year (2) community college or technical program, a four-year (4) accredited college program or institution, or seeking a post graduate degree from an accredited institution. To apply for the UCCC scholarship, please follow the instructions and applications guideline below. All applications will be reviewed by the scholarship committee and scored based on the student's academic record, recommendations and essay answers. The number and amount of scholarship awards will vary from year-to-year and is dependent upon the donations received during the award year. *Please note that any donation(s) to the fund are not 501c donation(s)*.

Scholarship Criteria

Requirement: All applicants must be dependent relatives son(s), daughter(s), legally adopted children or grandchildren) of UCCC members in good standing.

Criteria I: Post-Graduate

Eligible Requirements: Applicants must be enrolled in a Post-Graduate Program at an accredited Institution seeking a graduate degree. Applicants must provide supporting documentation of acceptance or current enrollment (acceptance letter, billing statement and/or other documents identifying enrollment).

Criteria II: Four-Year College or University

Eligible Requirements: Applicants must be graduating high school senior or currently enrolled in a four-year accredited institution seeking a Bachelor's Degree. Applicants must provide supporting documentation of acceptance or current enrollment (acceptance letter, billing statement and/or other documents identifying enrollment).

Criteria III: Community/Jr. College or Technical/Trade School

Eligible Requirements: Applicants must be a graduating high school senior or currently enrolled in an accredited Community/Junior College or Technical/Trade School seeking an Associate's Degree or a Certificate of Completion. Applicants must provide supporting documentation of acceptance or current enrollment (acceptance letter, billing statement and/or other documents identifying enrollment).

Disbursement

- Scholarship recipients will be notified by letter from the President of the UCCC.
- Scholarships will be awarded annually, subject to available funds.
- Scholarship awards will be made in July during UCCC's annual convention.
- The scholarship award will be deposited with the university, college or institution of higher learning to which the student is accepted, admitted, and will attend.
- The award money is credited to an account in the individual's name to be drawn upon for the following:
 - (1) Fees or charges required for tuition.
 - (2) Fees or charges for room and board while attending school.

- (3) Expenses for textbooks, course work, lab fees and other materials as required by a course instructor.
- Scholarship awards are not transferable to another individual or institution and are forfeited by the recipient upon withdrawal from the institution where the scholarship award was disbursed by the UCCC.

Consideration of Scholarship Applications

- The Scholarship Committee shall review the applications and make its recommendation to the Executive Board.
- After review of recommendations and related material, the Executive Board shall, in its sole discretion, decide upon the granting of the scholarships.

All materials must be received by midnight, May 31, 2017. (Do not bind the application)

- An official sealed copy of your school transcript report must be included in the application package or mailed directly from the registrar of the school. (Applicants must provide the current term of grades.) The official high school transcript should list all grade points earned and academic course work completed to date.
- The applicant must provide at least two (2) letters of recommendation.
 - (a) At least one letter of recommendation should be from a teacher, school administrator, counselor or work supervisor, who can address the qualification and/or academic aptitude of the scholarship applicant.
 - (b) Other recommendations can be from a coach or activity instructor, mentor or Sunday school teacher, etc...
 - (c) The required letters of recommendation <u>may not</u> be from any immediate family members, close family friends, or blood relatives.
 - (d) **Note:** Students should provide a brief statement of extra-curriculum activity involvement (within and outside of school).
- ESSAY The two essay questions should be answered in separate essays. Do Not Exceed the
 word limit for the essay questions. The Scholarship Committee is looking for concise and descriptive
 answers to the questions.
